## **AIR RACING RETURNS TO ROMANIA FOR FIRST EVENT OF 2008**

The organisers of Aero GP, one of the world's most exciting race series', have announced that the first Aero GP of 2008 will take place in Constanta, Romania on the 7 – 8 June. The air racing series which features multiple aircraft racing simultaneously at close quarters will descend upon the picturesque Mamaia beach in Constanta for the second year running, following the success of its Qualifying Grand Prix in 2007.

Set to be one of the most exciting and impressive air racing competitions to date, the Aero GP Constanta will see high-performance sport aircraft, flown by the world's finest pilots, take to the skies and compete over three disciplines; air racing, air-to-air combat and aerobatics in an attempt to win the coveted title of World Champion Flying Ace.

2008 will be the fourth consecutive Aero GP season, following on from previous years which included the Slovenia Grand Prix and the Betfair Grand Prix of Malta. As air sport events continue to grow in popularity, grabbing the attention of sports enthusiasts around the world, Aero GP continues to be one of the most exciting among them.

With this event Aero GP continues to lead the promotion of air racing in Europe.
